FOCUS OF THE MONTH

Communication & Language: Listening, understanding of instructions and routines, answer closed-ended questions, try to initiate conversation, increasing vocabulary and listening to 'The Ugly Duckling' Story.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development: Learning to play in small groups, manage their feelings and behaviour, learn to make choices and make decisions, show preference in what they want to do.

Physical Development: Learning to make large movements, throw & catch balls, hold and use writing tools
Literacy (English): Phonic sounds and songs of 'p', 'i' and 'n' as well as words beginning with these letters.

Literacy (Arabic): Phonic sounds of letters spoken with lips 'faa' and 'waaw' and words beginning with these letters
Mathematics: Counting and Recognizing 1, 2 and 3 numerals, 2D Shape 'Triangle' and 3D Shape 'Pyramid', learn to compare sizes (big and small)

Understanding the World: Learning about different countries, different people and develop positive attitude towards these differences they notice.

Expressive Arts & Design: Explore different materials, create 'small worlds', take part in 'pretend' play, use their imagination, make marks as well as sing and dance.

Week #1 (3rd to 7th November): The UAE – Children will recognize the name, location and flag of their residing country – the UAE.

Week #2: (10th to 14th November): My Country– Children will learn about 2 countries, their location, flag, foods, clothes and traditions (India & Sri Lanka).

Week #3: (17th to 21st November): My Country – Children will learn about 2 countries, their location, flag, foods, clothes and traditions (Pakistan & Philippines).

Week #4: (24th to 28th November): My Country – Children will learn about 2 countries, their location, flag, foods, clothes and traditions (African Countries).
